Activities, Crafts & More:

We offer a wide range of activities and craft, such as Archery, BB Riflery, Airsoft*, 22 Riflery*, Drama, Disc Golf, Sports, Arts & Crafts, Swimming, Canoeing, Skin Diving*, Sailing* and more. You will be able to choose two daily crafts for the week, so here's your chances to work on some skills, or maybe even trying something new! Each day also includes singing, a daily Bible story and plenty of games, fun and special surprises!

**Some activities and crafts have age or skill requirements. Craft availability is subject to change.*



Overnight, too! We hope you will join us for our overnight camp experience on Thursday night, August 13th. In addition to our normal day's fun, we will enjoy an extended time together, including our famous skit night and campfire, and a sleep over in our rustic cabins. New England Frontier Camp will provide Thursday's supper and Friday's breakfast!

(Note: Although overnight participants must be at least 8 years old, 6 & 7 year olds are encouraged to join us for Thursday supper and Friday breakfast!)



Day Camp is for boys and girls who are age 6 (as of August 1st) through age 14. The overnight program is for ages 8 through 14.

Time & Food Each day begins at 9 AM and runs until 4 PM, from Monday, August 10th through Friday, August 14th. Children need to bring a bag lunch, but New England Frontier Camp will provide milk or water. Each afternoon, the camp store will be open to purchase candy, soda, ice cream, T-Shirts and more.

Transportation is provided from the Charlotte Hobbs Memorial Library in Lovell, with additional stops along the route. The bus will leave from the library at 8:30 AM Monday through Thursday, and will return at approximately 4:30 PM each day except for Thursday. Parents are also welcome to drop off and pick up their children at camp.

Sunday Open House An Open House for Parents and Campers will be held on Sunday August 9th from 2 PM until 5 PM. Parents will be able to meet the staff and complete registration while the campers will be able to sign up for crafts and take their swimming test.

The **Individual Registration Fee** for Day Camp is \$175.00, which includes a \$75 non-refundable deposit. The balance is due no later than Monday, August 10th at the time of registration.

Family Registration Fees: Do you have more than one child of Day Camp age? We'd like to help you! For families sending more than one child to Day Camp, each additional registered child is eligible for a reduced registration fee, as follows:

- 1st Child's Registration: \$175.00
- 2nd Child's Registration: \$160.00
- 3rd Child's Registration: \$145.00
- 4th Child's Registration: \$145.00, etc.

A \$75.00 non-refundable deposit is required for each child's registration.

To register, please mail the attached registration form to New England Frontier Camp along with your deposit. Upon receiving your deposit, we will send a receipt, welcome letter and medical forms to you.

Campership The Lovell Recreation Department sponsors a campership program to help local children attend the camp of their choice. Register your child for Day Camp and we will provide a letter of acceptance that can be used to redeem an \$80.00 campership from the Lovell Town Office. *This campership is only available to residents of Lovell, ME who are in grades 3 – 8 as of April 15th, 2009.*

Dear Parents and Guardians,

New England Frontier Camp has taken safety measures to conduct safe programs, including having certified staff in first aid, CPR and water safety. We believe it is important to inform our families that any outdoor camping and recreational activity has inherent dangers that no amount of care, caution, instruction or expertise can eliminate. We believe that young people seek adventure and that camp provides an ideal environment for exploring new activities in a prescribed and safe manner. However, some activities may involve risks that young people do not encounter every day. Examples at New England Frontier Camp include activities in and on the water while swimming, sailing, canoeing, snorkeling, white water rafting, water skiing, tubing and wake boarding. Land activities may include rock climbing, rappelling, riflery, BB guns, air soft, archery, bicycling, travel in camp vans, and activities in the facilities of on the trail where inclement weather may be involved. Camp participants must also assume the infrequent but inescapable risks with such activities.

IT IS MANDATORY THAT THIS FORM BE FILLED OUT, SIGNED AND DATED BY THE PARENT(S) OR GUARDIAN(S) OF THE CAMPER AND RETURNED WITH THE REGISTRATION FEE. YOUR CAMPER WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND CAMP UNLESS WE RECEIVE THIS SIGNED FORM.

- I hereby affirm that I have been advised of and understand the risks of camping and recreational activities at New England Frontier Camp and that such activities involve dangers and risks and I accept those dangers and risks knowingly.
- I understand that pictures and videos are taken at camp. I hereby give permission for the use of such pictures and videos for the promotion of New England Frontier Camp. I release and waive any and all claims arising out of the use by New England Frontier Camp and its authorized designee of my camper's likeness and/or voice on film, video tape, or sound recording, in any news program, documentary, educational film, promotional literature, feature film and/or program or picture, which may be exhibited or broadcast on television, radio, CATV, motion picture theaters, schools, or other educational institutions.
- I give permission for my camper to be transported in vehicles for camp approved transportation and activities at New England Frontier Camp and other locations.
- I understand that the terms herein are contractual and not a mere recital.
- In signing this document, I hereby certify that I give permission to my camper to participate in the camping program of New England Frontier Camp.
- I have signed this document as my own free act and in consideration of the agreement by New England Frontier Camp to accept my camper for the camp program indicated on the registration form.
