

# NEW ENGLAND FRONTIER CAMP

Welcome to the New England Frontier Camp 2008 Camper Family! We are so pleased that your son will be with us at Camp. ## Camper Information Form

## Prior to Your Son's Arrival

It is helpful to receive the Camper Information Form and Camper Medical Form prior to your son's arrival at camp. **Please note: If your son is taking a prescription medication, he must have a signed statement from a doctor stating he is cleared to attend camp and participate in its activities.**

## Arrival and Departure

Plan to arrive between 1:30 and 4:00 pm on Sunday for registration located at A-Lodge (lakefront Building). Light refreshments will be served. Once registration is complete, your son can then move into his cabin and take a swim test at the waterfront (weather permitting).

Please note that registration will not begin before 1:30pm. Departure takes place Saturday morning between 10:00 and 11:30 am. Please be on time.

## Father and Son Programs

The Father and Son program consists of 2 three day programs during the week of July 20-26. Arrivals take place on Sunday the 20<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday the 23<sup>th</sup> between 1:30 and 4pm. Departures take place on Wednesday the 22<sup>th</sup> and Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> between 10:00 and 11:30am. Sunday registration is held in A-Lodge (Lakeside) while Wednesday registration will be held in B-Lodge ((Up the hill overlooking the lake).

## Communication While at Camp

Letters are highly encouraged! The camp business telephone is not available for routine calls to or from campers. Should you need to contact your son in an emergency, do not hesitate to call NE Frontier Camp and ask to speak to the Camp Director.

## Laundry Services

Limited laundry services are available at \$ 2.00 per load for campers during multiple week sessions. Please pack enough clean clothing to last for 7-14 days. Please supply a laundry bag with a draw string labeled with your camper's name on it (No plastic trash bags please).

## Care Packages

Care packages and letters are encouraged. Campers love to get a package with an assortment of fun items in it. Please use your imagination, but no food items please. Because we are in a very wooded environment we do not allow food in our cabins due to the wonderful wildlife friends we can have at Camp.
